

Circumstances Requiring ICU Attending Notification

- Any time you are concerned about a patient
- Any unstable patient
- Any potential procedures
- New admissions (including trauma patients)
- Prior to calling new consult unless discussed prior
- Prior to ordering CT or MRI even if consult orders
- Persistent hypotension
- Increasing vasopressor requirement
- Need for intubation or re-intubation
- Worsening hypoxia
- Significant ventilator changes (anything other than adjusting respiratory rate and FiO₂)
- Persistent cuff leak
- Inability to suction through an endotracheal tube
- Inability to bag valve mask ventilate a patient
- Self-extubation
- Persistent high pressure alarms on ventilator
- Any change in neurologic status
- Any concern about ICP monitoring
- Persistent oliguria
